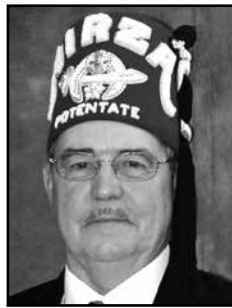

COLOR GUARD

Additional Points to Bear in Mind in Paying Homage to the Flag:

A Noble who is wearing his Fez will execute a right hand salute when the Colors are within six paces of him. He will not remove his Fez. After the Colors have passed he should drop his right hand. In case the same Colors pass the same point again, as frequently happens in Ceremonial procession or in display drills, the Colors need not be saluted a second time. The same applies to street parades.

During the ceremony of hoisting or lowering the Flag or when the Flag is passing in a parade or in review, all persons present except those in uniform should face the flag and stand at attention with the right hand over the heart. Those present in uniform and a Shrine Noble should render the military salute. When not in uniform, men should remove their headgear with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart. Veterans may render the military salute.

During the rendition of the

national Anthem when the Flag is displayed, all persons present except those in uniform should face the flag and stand at attention with the right hand over the heart. Those present in uniform or a Shrine Noble should render the military salute. When not in uniform, men should remove their headgear with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart. Persons in uniform should render the military salute at the first note of the Anthem and retain this position until the last note. Veterans may render the military salute.

Be Burn Aware!

Keep Children Safe from Scalds

Every day, hundreds of young children with burn injuries caused by scalding are taken to emergency rooms. Scald burns (caused by hot liquids, steam or foods) are one of the most common burn injuries among children age 4 and younger. Many of these injuries could have been prevented with a few simple precautions:

Be Safe In The Bathroom!

- LOWER THE WATER HEATER TEMPERATURE TO 120°F (49°C) OR LESS.
- WHEN FILLING THE BATHTUB, RUN COLD WATER FIRST, AND MIX IN WARMER WATER
- BEFORE PLACING A CHILD IN THE BATHTUB, CHECK THE WATER TEMPERATURE BY RAPIDLY MOVING YOUR HAND THROUGH THE WATER. IF THE WATER FEELS HOT TO AN ADULT, IT IS TOO HOT FOR A CHILD.
 - IN THE BATHTUB, FACE THE CHILD AWAY FROM FAUCETS.
 - USE KNOB COVERS ON FAUCETS.
- ALWAYS SUPERVISE CHILDREN IN THE BATH.

Be Kitchen & Dining room Smart Too!

- USE OVEN MITTS OR POT HOLDERS WHEN COOKING.
- TURN POT HANDLES INWARD.
- THOROUGHLY STIR ALL MICROWAVED FOOD.
- NEVER HEAT BABY BOTTLES IN A MICROWAVE.
- PROVIDE SUPERVISION TO CHILDREN UNDER AGE 7 USING A MICROWAVE
- DO NOT USE DEEP FRYERS AROUND CHILDREN.
