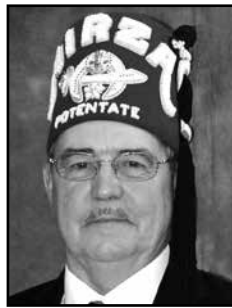

AMENDMENT TO MIRZA BY-LAWS

Section 5.2:

The annual dues shall be determined at a stated or special meeting of the temple after notice has been given to each member stating the proposed amount of the annual dues. Effective January 1, 2019, the annual dues of Mirza Shriners shall be Sixty-Five Dollars (\$65.00), payable to the Recorder in advance before January 1. The annual dues do not include the hospital levy or the annual per capita tax required by the bylaws of Shriners International, each of which shall be added to the annual dues. This temple may, by affirmative vote, remit dues of a member for good cause shown either to the temple or a committee selected for that purpose. All candidates initiated and members restored or affiliated between January 1 and March 31 shall pay 100%; between April 1 and June 30, 75%; between July 1 and September 30, 50%; between October 1 and December 31, 25%, which proportionate amounts shall constitute the dues of the candidates and members restored or affiliated to December 31 for the then current year.

- (a) **Suspension for nonpayment.** A member who is one year in arrears on his dues is suspended, pursuant to the procedure recited in the bylaws of Shriners International, unless this temple votes to remit his dues.
- (b) **Restoration.** A member who has been suspended for nonpayment of dues may be restored to membership pursuant to the procedure prescribed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

Every day, hundreds of young children with burn injuries caused by scalding are taken to emergency rooms. Scald burns (caused by hot liquids, steam or foods) are one of the most common burn injuries among children age 4 and younger. Many of these injuries could have been prevented with a few simple precautions:

Be Safe In The Bathroom!

- LOWER THE WATER HEATER TEMPERATURE TO 120°F (49°C) OR LESS.
- WHEN FILLING THE BATHTUB, RUN COLD WATER FIRST, AND MIX IN WARMER WATER
- BEFORE PLACING A CHILD IN THE BATHTUB, CHECK THE WATER TEMPERATURE BY RAPIDLY MOVING YOUR HAND THROUGH THE WATER. IF THE WATER FEELS HOT TO AN ADULT, IT IS TOO HOT FOR A CHILD.
- IN THE BATHTUB, FACE THE CHILD AWAY FROM FAUCETS.
- USE KNOB COVERS ON FAUCETS.
- ALWAYS SUPERVISE CHILDREN IN THE BATH.

Be Kitchen & Dining room Smart Too!

- USE OVEN MITTS OR POT HOLDERS WHEN COOKING.
- TURN POT HANDLES INWARD.
- THOROUGHLY STIR ALL MICROWAVED FOOD.
- NEVER HEAT BABY BOTTLES IN A MICROWAVE.
- PROVIDE SUPERVISION TO CHILDREN UNDER AGE 7 USING A MICROWAVE
- DO NOT USE DEEP FRYERS AROUND CHILDREN.
