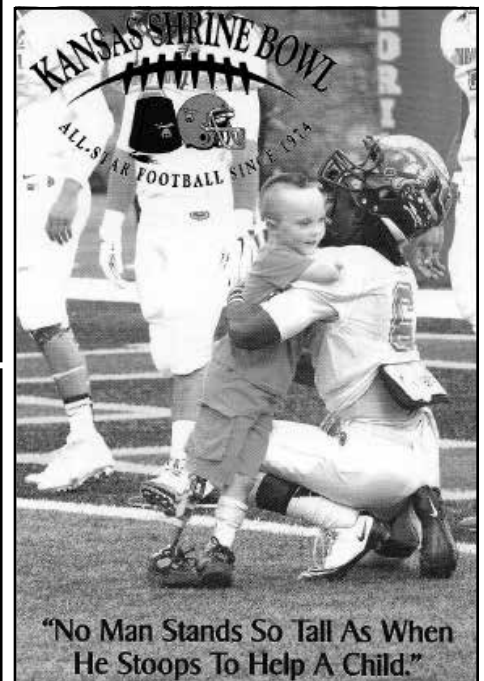

First, let's look at the top of the flagpole that holds our beloved American flag. The ball on the very top is called a "truck." On an official government installation, inside the truck is a .9mm caliber bullet. In the event a truck falls and hits the ground, it is designed to break into 13 individual pieces. The 13 pieces represent the original colonies.

At the base of each flagpole, that is located on an official government installation, is a box buried in concrete. This box contains one saber, a .9mm caliber pistol, a razor blade, and a book of matches. In the event the enemy overtakes the last government installation, the survivor is to defend the flag with


the saber and pistol, shred and burn the flag with the razor blade and matches, so that the enemy cannot capture the flag.

The next time you say the Pledge of Allegiance or watch "Old Glory" fly proudly above a government installation, keep in mind what is housed within the body of the flagpole. Not just the items within, but remember what they represent and the dedication each American should hold for their country. Remember the men and women of those 13 colonies, who were the founders of our great nation. Remember the devotion to duty, God and country, that the veterans of all wars held so dear, and the sacrifices given for our freedom. Remember the dedication of all

Americans, who may be called upon to defend their nation in time of war. And remember if you are the last one standing between our glorious flag and the enemy. You Are To Do Your Duty. The facts about the American Flag was gleaned from the Palm Beach Thistle, and the Army National Guard.
