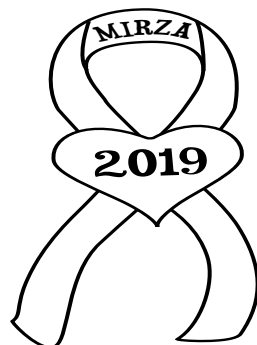
The Nobell luncheon will be held on September 14th. I am looking forward to spending some time with these very special ladies.

Mirza Temple dues have increased from \$42.00 per year to \$65.00 per year. When added with per capita and Hospital assessment that makes your Shrine dues total \$100.00 per year. There is a way to reduce your Temple dues. Purchase a Lifetime Temple Membership. You can do that by submitting \$65.00 times 20 or \$1300.00 for the Lifetime Temple Dues. The result of that purchase would reduce your Shrine dues to \$35.00 per year. Currently Total Lifetime Membership costs After January 1st 2019, Total Lifetime Membership will cost \$2,350.00. You can also purchase separately Hospital Life for \$150.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$95.00 per year. You can also purchase separately Per Capita Life for \$900.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$70.00 per year. These Life memberships maybe purchased separately if you so chose. 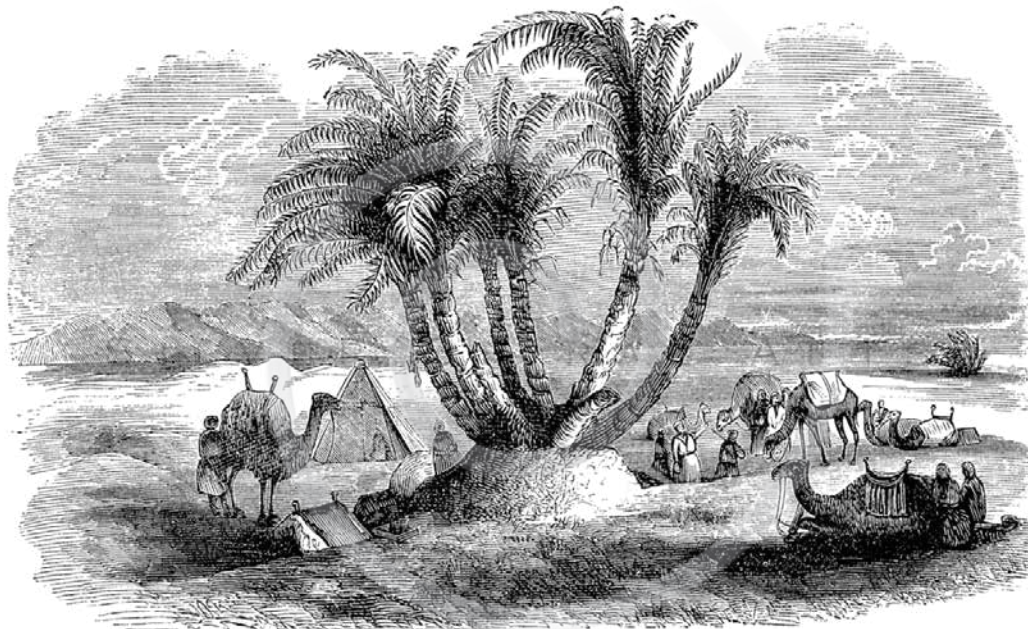

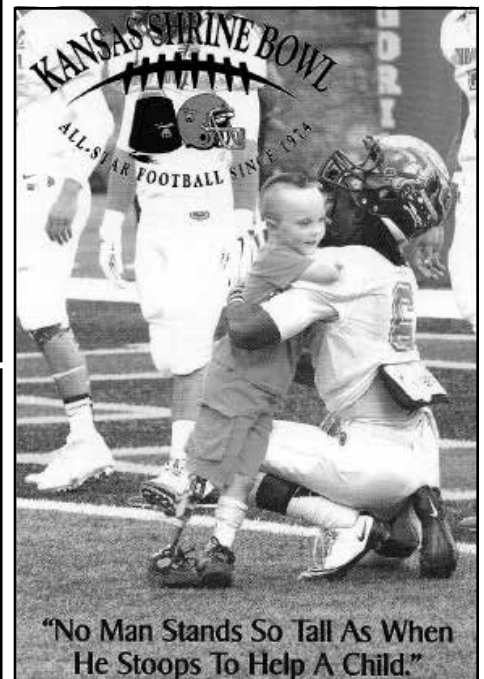

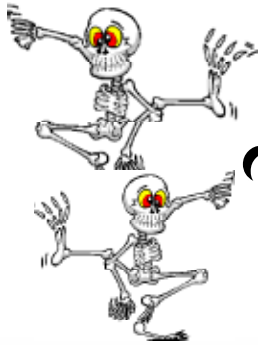

OFFICIAL CALL FOR THE
ANNUAL SESSION
JANUARY 15th, 2020

The Annual Session of Mirza Shrine, Shriners International, for the election of Officers, Financial Advisory Committee members and representatives for the ensuing year and the presentation of the reports of the Treasurer and Recorder will be held Wednesday, JANUARY 15TH, 2020

Please note the following paragraphs of Article 25 of the Shriners International By-Laws:

325.4 **When elected.** Each Temple must elect its Officers and Representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December.

325.5 **Ballot.**

(a) **Separate Ballot.** Election of officers shall be by a majority vote of those present and voting. When there is more than one candidate for election to a particular office, a separate written ballot is required. A blanket ballot is prohibited.

(b) **Retention.** The ballots cast in any contested election for temple office shall be retained in the custody of the Recorder for a period of 90 days following the election, after which they may be destroyed unless the Imperial Potentate otherwise orders.

(c) **Void Ballot.** Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

325.6 **Time of election.** Nominations must commence not later than 9:00 p.m. and when that hour arrives all other business must cease and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.

325.7 **Other officers.** The Temple may elect such other officers as its By-laws provide.

325.8 **Nomination.** Candidates for offices and Representative must be placed in nomination from the floor

325.10 **Representatives.**

(a) **Single Ballot.** Where a Temple elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.

(b) **Complete Ballot.** Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.

(c) **Majority Vote.** A majority vote of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative

(d) **Election.** Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.

(e) **Successive Ballots.** Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.

(f) **Highest Vote.** If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representative to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.

(g) **Void Ballot.** Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.

Shriners International By-laws requires that you have your 2020 card to attend this Session.

325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple is prohibited.

(b) **Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) **Notice.** At Least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS OF SHRINERS INTERNATIONAL

ARTICLE 23, 323.3 Prerequisite for Membership.

(a) Prerequisite. A temple may not accept a petition from a candidate unless he is in good standing as a Master Mason in a Grand Lodge which meets the recognition standards of the Grand Masters Conference in North America, Interamerican Masonic Confederation (CMI) or the World Conference of Grand Lodges.

ARTICLE 39, 339.1 Admission. A Noble may not be admitted to his own or any other temple, unless he exhibits to the temple to which he desires admittance an official Shrine card for the then current year.
