You can also purchase separately Hospital Life for \$150.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$95.00 per year. You can also purchase separately Per Capita Life for \$900.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$70.00 per year. These Life memberships maybe purchased separately if you so choose.

“All care and services are provided regardless of the families’ ability to pay” is the correct phrase to use when describing the cost of care. Do not use free, at no cost, at no charge or without financial obligation.

Please take a moment to check your materials, including your websites, and make sure we are all communicating consistently. It is critically important to the strength and success of our message. If we all speak with one clear, consistent voice, imagine the impact we could have.
