Hello Nobles, Ladies and Freinds


Greetings and cheers to all! As we begin our trek for the New Year throughout the MIRZA jurisdiction, I must first thank

Purchase a Lifetime Temple Membership. You can do that by submitting \$65.00 times 20 or \$1300.00 for the Lifetime Temple Dues. The result of that purchase would reduce your Shrine dues to \$35.00 per year. Currently Total Lifetime Membership costs after January 1st 2019, Total Lifetime Membership will cost \$2,350.00. You can also purchase separately Hospital Life for \$150.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$95.00 per year. You can also purchase separately Per Capita Life for \$900.00 reducing Shrine dues to \$70.00 per year. These Life memberships maybe purchased separately if you so choose.

Those are important goals. In order to achieve them we need our messages to be accurate and consistent – from print materials to electronic media.




